

Please read Camp Policies carefully.

- 1) For promotional purposes, we will be taking photos of campers in their day-to-day activities. If you do not wish your child's image to be used in this manner, please inform our camp director by the first day of camp. If we do not hear from you, *Celina's String Studio Summer Music & Stepdance Camp* assumes consent to the use of your child's photo(s) in Camp publicity material.
- 2) Campers **must** be picked-up ***on time*** at the end of each camp day **by 4pm**. Additional fees apply after this time.
- 3) Please notify in advance if a child will be absent or late for camp. We will call the parent numbers or the alternate contact if your child has an uninformed absence.
- 4) **Cancelation Policy:** If registration is cancelled more than 30 days prior to the start of the week AND we can resell your spot, a refund is granted. There will be no refunds if you miss a camp day or cancel with less than 14 days' notice prior to the first day of camp, or we can't resell it. Spaces are limited!
- 5) **Rules and Expectations of Behaviour.** On the first day of camp, the rules and expectation of behaviour will be discussed with all our campers in a group setting. We do this to help our campers understand how their behaviour affects the music camp experience for everyone. We would like to share some of these rules and expectations with you in the hopes that you will discuss them with your family before camp starts. It is our wish and responsibility to create a positive camp environment between all participants at camp.
 - A. Respect and cooperation are essential elements in establishing a safe environment that encourages artistic development and freedom. Campers and staff are expected to be a positive influence on all camp participants. If a camper is disturbing the camp atmosphere, staff will discuss the issue with the camper and family. If the camper consistently disregards the camp rules, the camper will be asked to leave camp.
 - B. Bullying, exclusion and humiliation will not be tolerated at Camp. If a camper sees or experiences any of these situations, it is important to let a staff member know. Any of these behaviours from a camper, will result the camper being asked to leave camp.
 - C. Respect for the buildings and grounds we use at camp is very important. We expect our campers to treat their environment with care and keep the grounds clean.

Covid-19 Protocols and Policy

The following measures have been put in place to promote the health and safety of campers and staff at our *Summer Music & Stepdance Camp 2024*:

- Masks are not required at *Summer Music & Stepdance Camp*. However, campers and staff are welcome to wear a mask if they wish.
- Proper hand hygiene, including frequent hand washing and sanitizing, is encouraged.
- Campers will spend part of each day outdoors, weather permitting. Eating and drinking will take place outdoors whenever possible.
- Do not send your child to camp if they feel unwell or have symptoms.
